Gentlemen (and women).....start your engines! What's more exciting than a warm summer evening at the races? Just 20 minutes (17 miles) north of our gate is the Lee County Fairgrounds in Donnellson, Iowa, this $\frac{3}{8}$ mile, dirt oval track has produced some of the finest stock car racers in history. Ernie Derr, Don White, Dick Hutcherson and Ramo Stott all got their start here. During one three year period (1964-1966) three of those drivers won all but two races in the IMCA. They were often referred to as the "Keokuk connection" among competing drivers on the circuit. Races begin in April and end in late October. There are races on the schedule every Friday and many Saturday evenings throughout the summer.
